

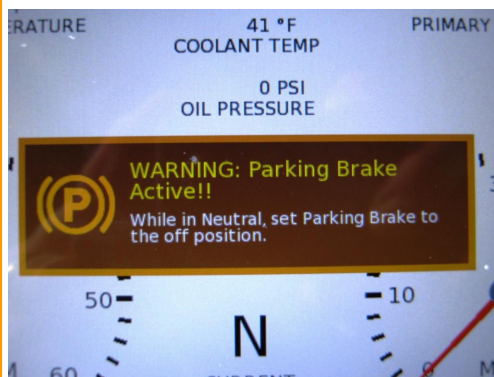


E-BRAKE BLADE CONTROL MAINTENANCE SEMINARS

E-BRAKE

Starting this summer all Sno-Cat® vehicle E-Brakes will, while engaged, keep the transmission in neutral. This is an added safety feature that not only saves wear and tear on the E-Brake but keeps an inadvertent gear engagement from moving the vehicle. With the E-Brake engaged you will see a warning message on the digital dash. If at that point the gear selector is engaged you will also see the RANGE INHIBIT warning light come on. Please see below for an example of the warnings.

Last month we stated that an audio alarm would also be involved, we have decided to drop the audio alarm. As an additional safety measure the foot brake pedal must be pressed to engage the transmission. This requires a special switch and in the case of a switch failure we will install a labeled red override push button just below the PowerView display. We will have three different ways to prevent premature gear engagement; the foot brake pedal not being pressed, the emergency brake engaged, and high engine rpm.



BLADE CONTROL

Starting with this summers production we will add a paddle to the front of the blade joystick control. This is a safety feature that must be engaged for the blade functions of up-down and tilt left-tilt right to work. Please see the picture to the right. Again this is for the up-down or tilt left-tilt right functions only.
