We just installed our first “New Dash” in a Model 2000 Terra. This new style will take up less room, be more user friendly, and is stronger than the current production. We will run three of these this season and make some small adjustments before it is released to production. We have already made one change since this picture and that is moving the radio back to the overhead compartment, which gives us more room for switches. The schedule is to have these in the 2013 production for Models 2000 and 1643RE. Another improvement we are looking at is adding a manual gear engagement lever for the Allison 3000 transmission, which is only available with the high horse power engines.
