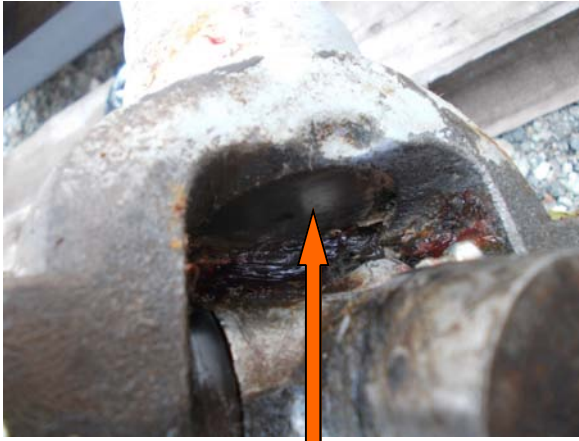

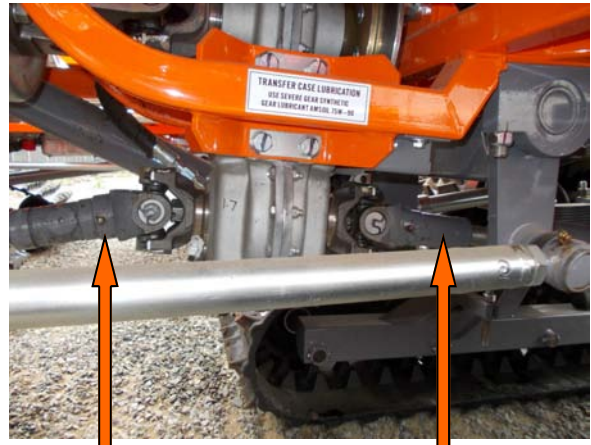

STERLING SAYS

Sterling says.....“In the process of maintaining your Sno-Cat® take a close look at the drive lines coming out of the transfer case. The crosses (aka u-joints) connect the yokes coming out of the transfer case to the yokes on the end of the drive lines. These drive line yokes float because the differential moves as a result of the pivot steering. The end of this yoke, facing the cross, has a plug (with a weep hole) pressed into it. The function of the plug is to keep grease inside so the yoke can easily move. If for some reason the yoke has move too far down the drive line, it could pop out the plug and you would lose your grease resulting in worn splines. While you are in the area also look at your crosses to make sure they have all their caps and the bolts are tensioned correctly.” See pictures below.

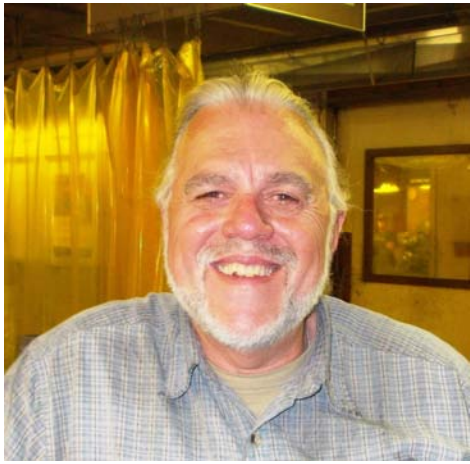
