This month Sterling talks about items mostly related to warm / dry weather. “If you are in dusty conditions check the air cleaner more often, tracked vehicles kick up a lot of dust. High speed travel on the paved roads during hot weather can cause the tracks to get hot, so slow down. Summer sunlight is tough on all vehicles, covering the tracks and windshield helps. If you are planning to install a battery master switch on our system make sure to get one that is rated at 600 amps with interim 1000 amp rating”.

He also says summer service has been really busy but if you have questions please do not hesitate to call, he still may be able to get you serviced before the snow starts. If you are looking for some older “gasser” parts, then see what we have listed on e-bay.
